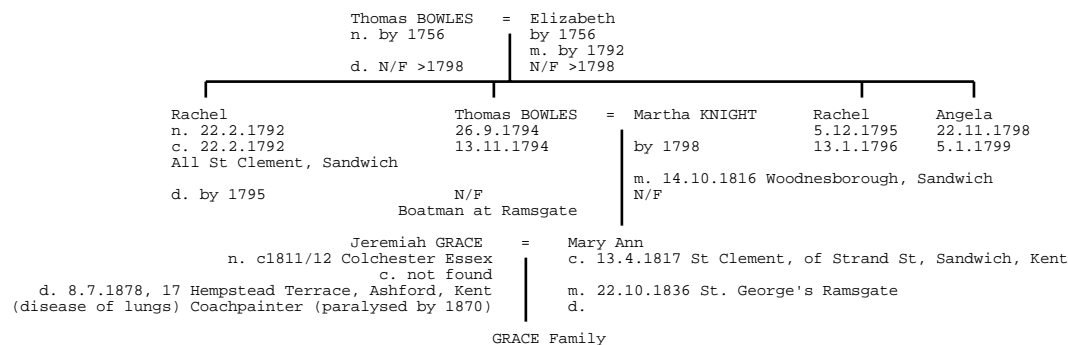


BOWLES FAMILY OF SANDWICH, KENT

Descendants of Thomas BOWLES & Martha (Ramsgate/Sandwich: Late C18th - Early C19th) [GRACE]



Thomas & Martha not on 1841 or 1851 census, most likely because either both dead or Thomas remarried.
