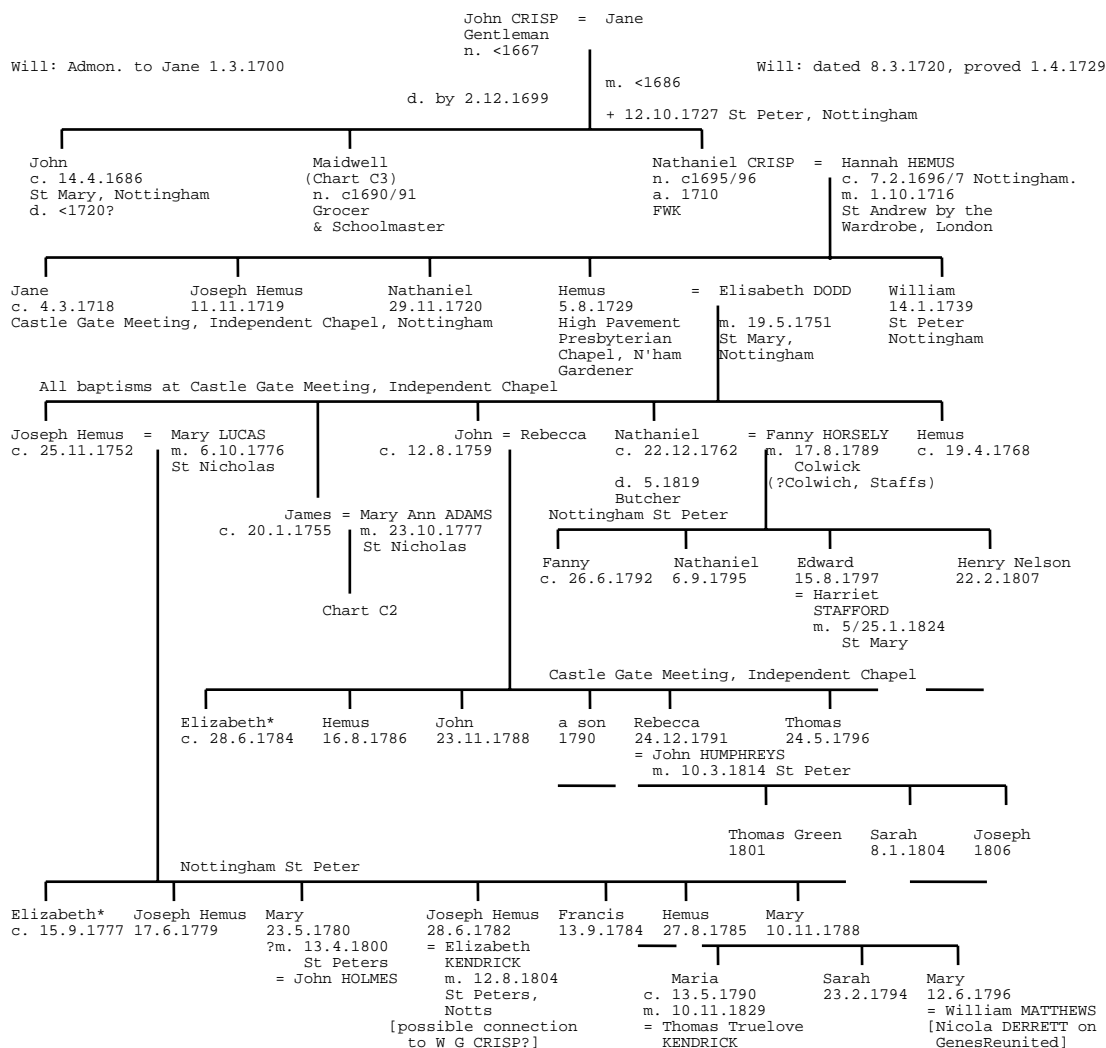

Nathaniel, butcher, Castle Gate. aged 49 in 1812 & 55 in 1816.

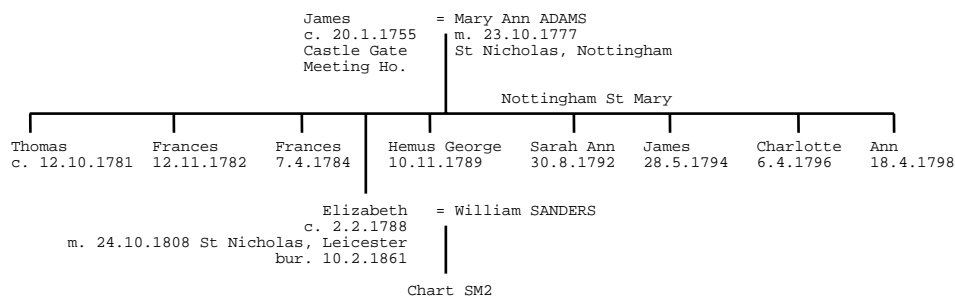

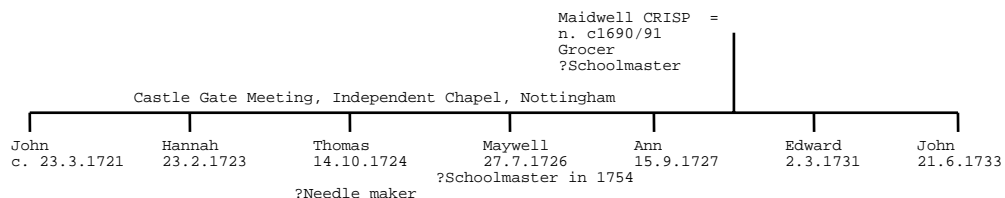
