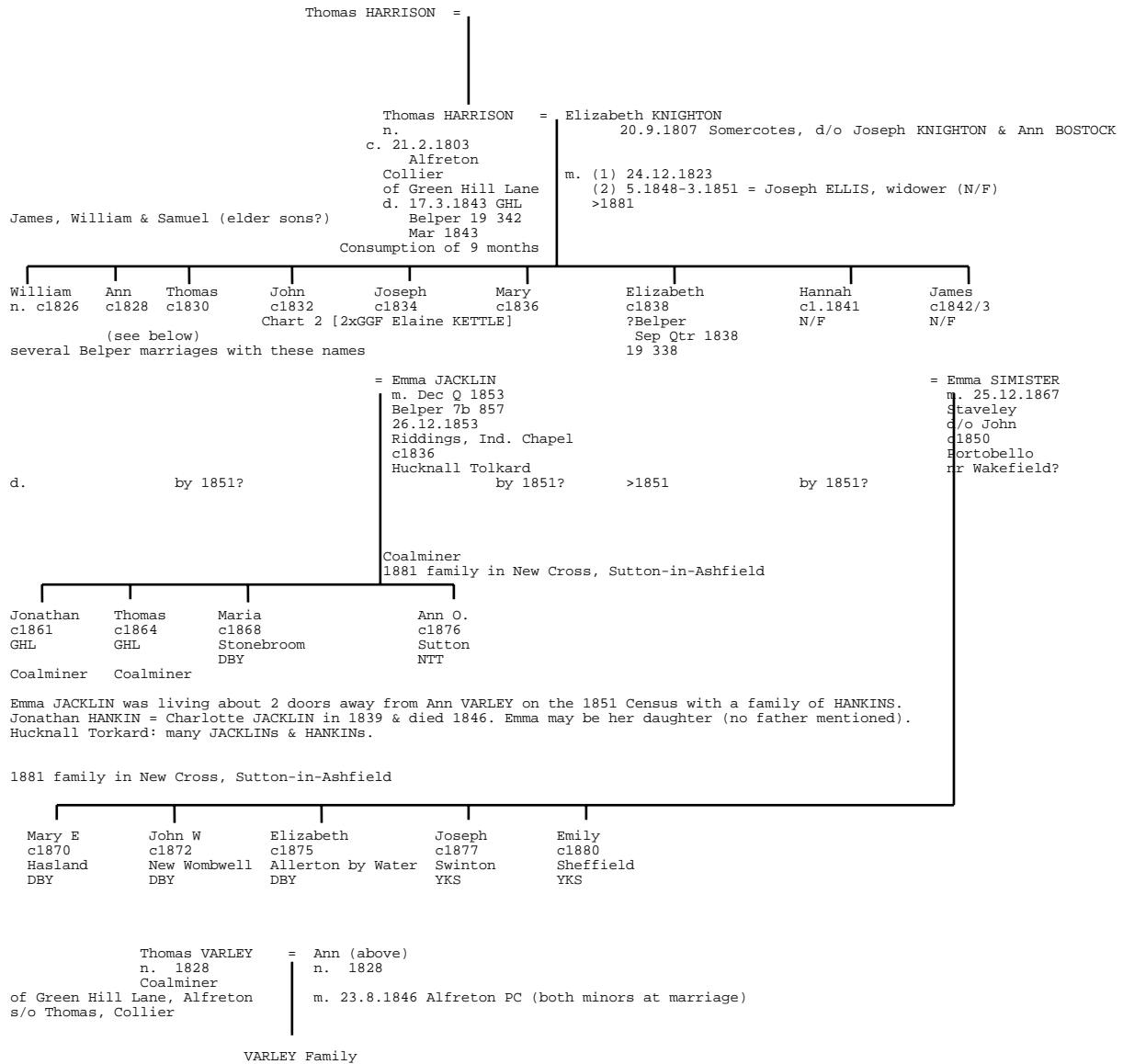

Notes

Thomas death possibly at Belper Mar 1843, 19 342 or Jun 1843, 19 300

Greenhill Lane (GHL):

not a street in Alfreton, but one apparently running between the villages of Swanwick (some GHL refs in 1841) and Riddings. The majority of references suggest that GHL is a district hamlet and is treated as a village in the 1851 census.

By 1881 Samson ELLIS, James ELLIS, Joseph HARRISON & James HARRISON were married and living with their families in New Cross, Sutton in Ashfield, Notts.

1881:

Elizabeth ELLIS living her sister Mary JOHNSON (Mary KNIGHTON = William JOHNSON in 1829) in Hasland. Joseph ELLIS also in Hasland.
