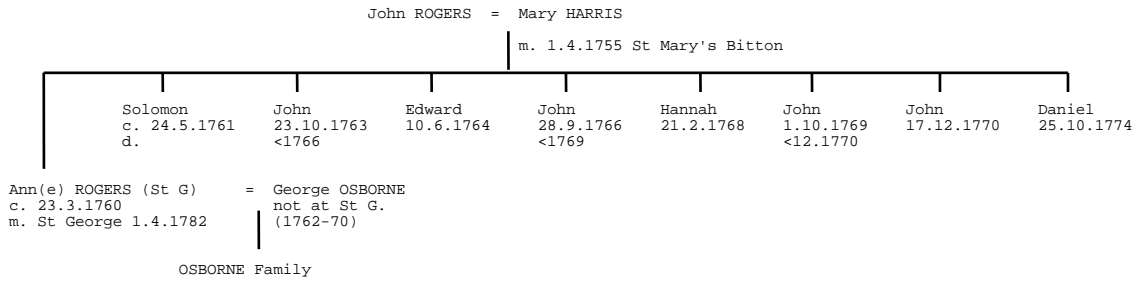

 Dennis identified as a male inhabitant of Oldland Bitton side in 1747

 Sailed 27.11.1831 on the "Gilmore".

 James 17.7.1739; John WESLEY wrote "In this frenzied atmosphere [he] "a leader of the colliers in wildness
 and sin" was converted, and became "more eminent in a religious way than previously in folly and
 wickedness". Before his conversion he had played the fiddle, scraping away on the few occasions when the
 colliers and families enjoyed themselves. Now with this harmless entertainment considered sinful, he "broke and
 burnt his fiddle, as it had previously been associated with his drunken carousals".
