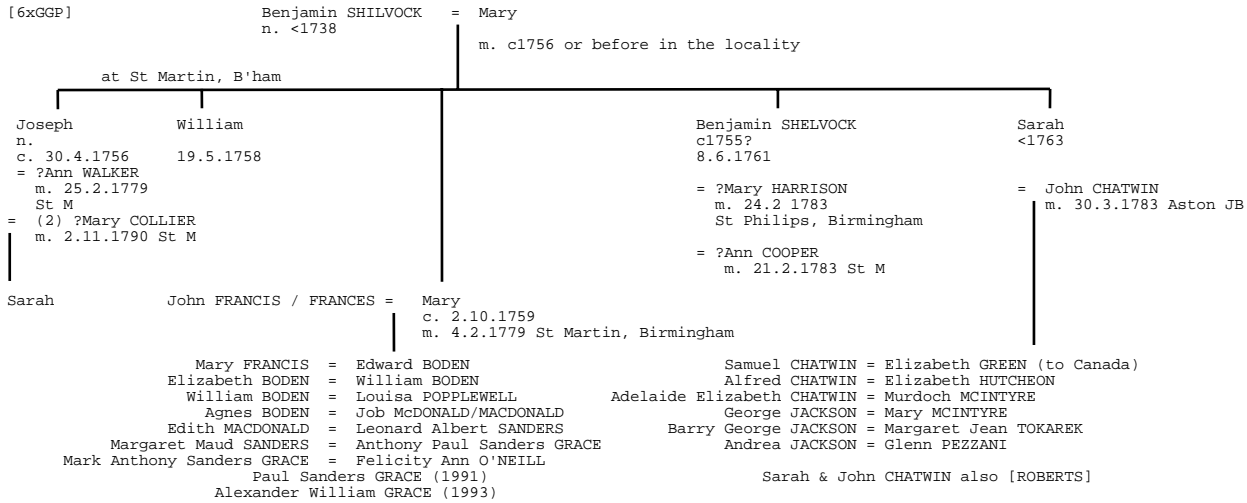

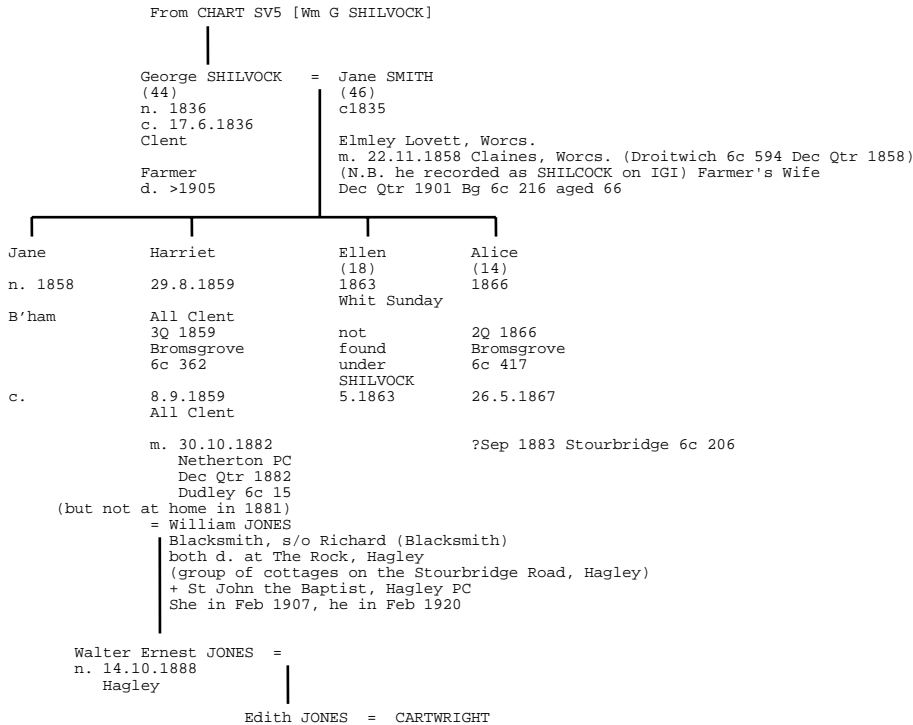
Status: Seeking C18th/C19th Descendants to connect to main clan in Halesowen, possibly from the Romsley family tree?
 Need to research all Benjamin marriages at St Philips & St Martin's, Birmingham to clarify partners.
 A Benjamin aged 74 (n. c1755) was buried at Halesowen on 15.3.1829

Current Benjamin "candidates":

Benjamin m. Elizabeth STEVENS or STEPHENS at Halesowen in 1746. This could be the first wife of the above, with Mary being the second marriage. No Benjamin birth/baptism, no Elizabeth death or Ann marriage dates found.

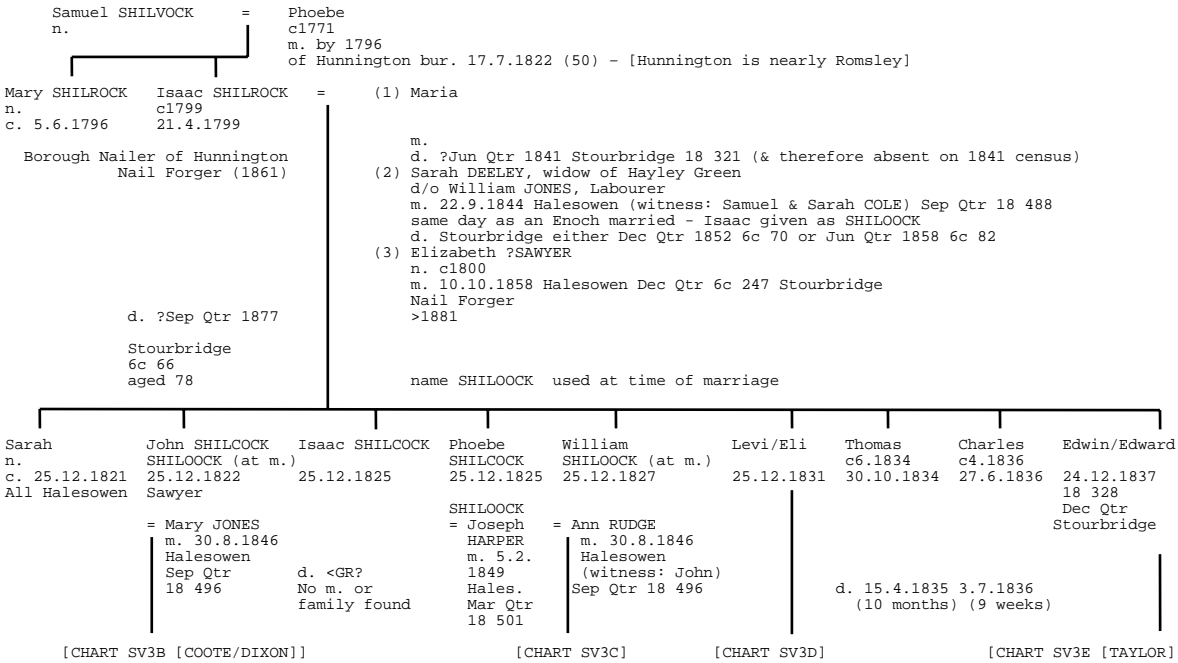

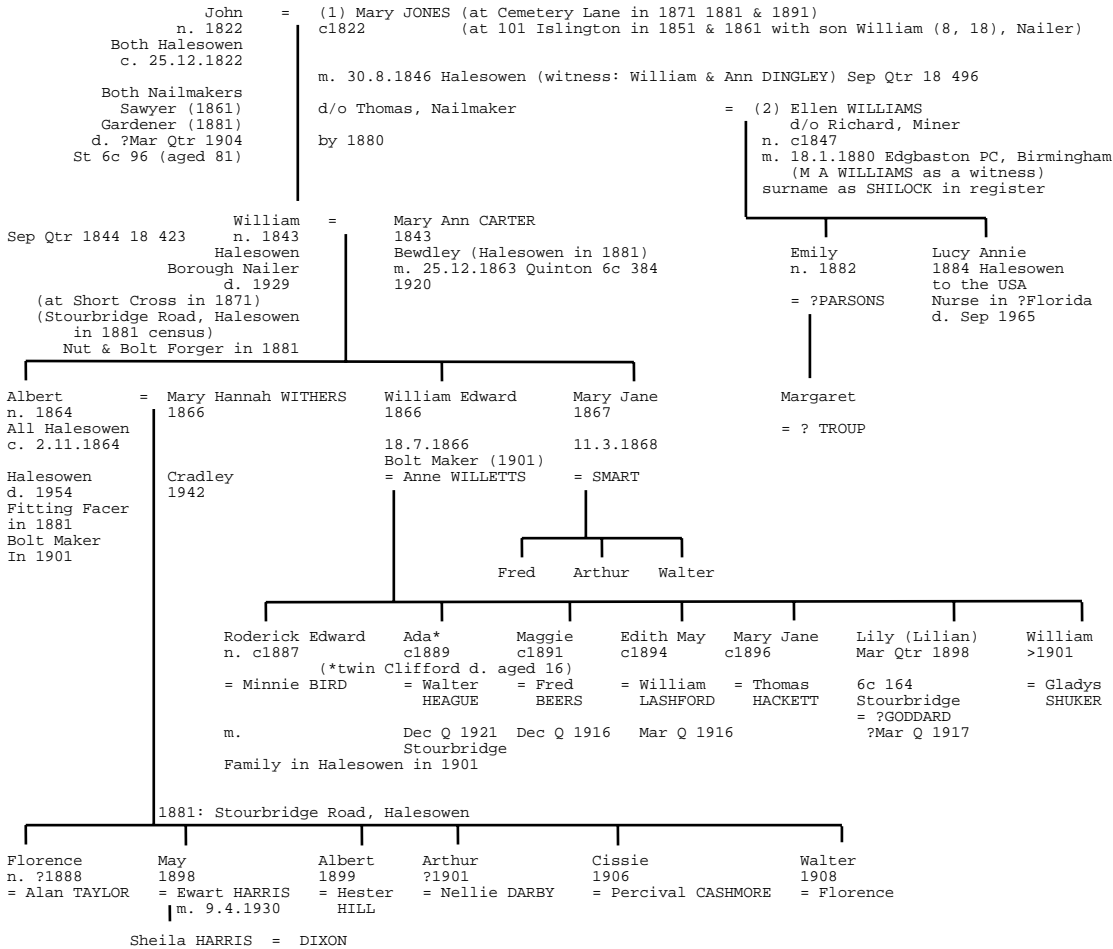

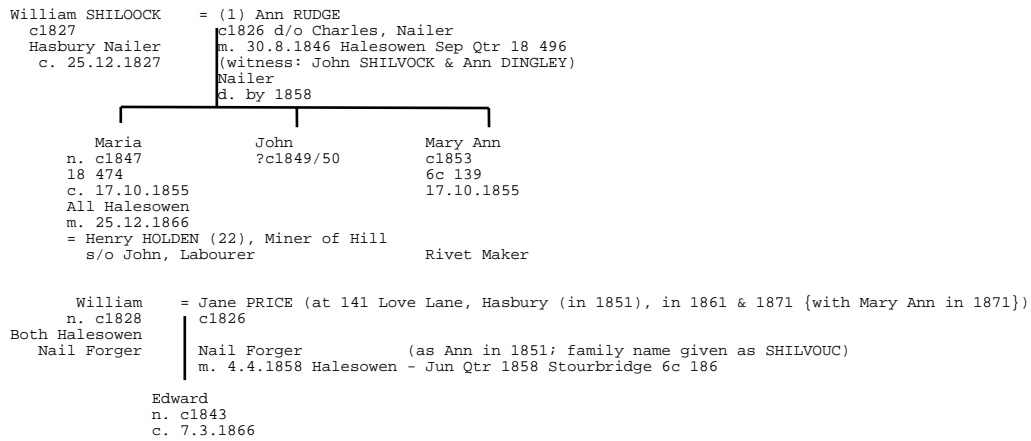
Robin BIRD narrates:

Edward Roderick SHILVOCK was the second husband of my paternal GM Minnie Grace (nee Taylor then Bird). They married at Bearwood Baptist Church in Smethwick, West Midlands in July 1940 and lived at 40, Willow Avenue, Edgbaston. He died in March 1954 when I was only a year old - Of her 3 husbands, Frank BIRD, Edward SHILVOCK and Albert SIMCOIX, Edward was the one that my GM most loved and after the death of her 3rd husband Albert she changed her name by deed poll back to SHILVOCK.
Edward SHILVOCK was buried in Quinton Cemetery in a grave with a Black Headstone. In April 1989 following her own death Minnie Grace TAYLOR/BIRD/SHILVOCK/SIMCOX (October 1890 - April 1989) but was always known as "Minnie SHILVOCK" was buried in the same grave. He was an engineer of some kind (boat builder?) and that he did produce some very good wrought iron work for members of the family.

Sheila's uncle spoke of a Henry & Maria HOLDEN who visited.

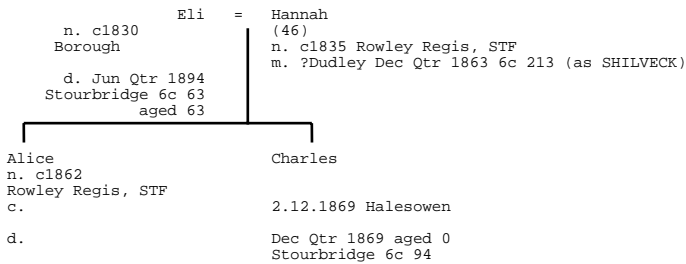

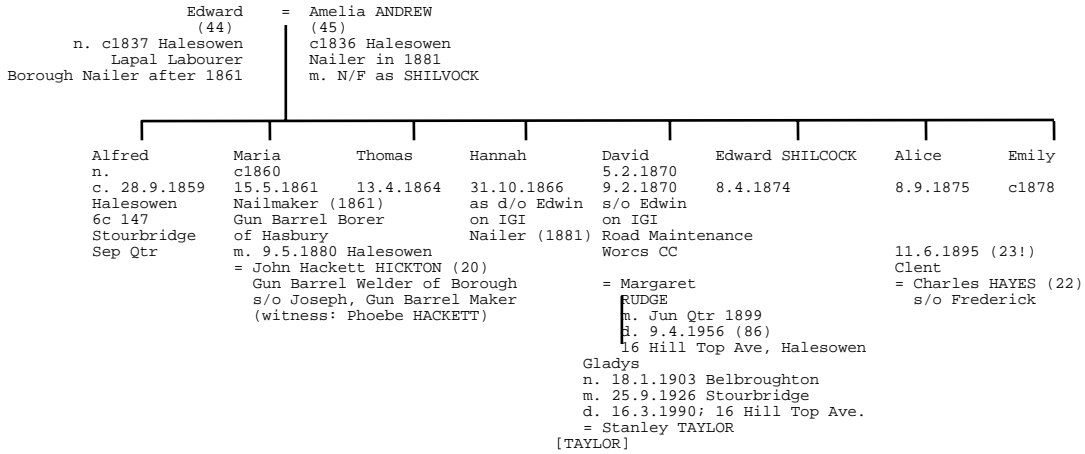

Maternal grandmother was the 7th of 13 children of Joseph & Caroline (has photos of the couple). They lived in Wall Well, Halesowen and she still have an Aunt there.

Joseph was a master musician and played the organ and piano in Halesowen, Romsley and Worcester Cathedral. He worked at the button factory. It was said that the SHILVOCKS came from Eastern Europe and were descendants of red-haired Jewish gypsies. Another has said that they set up a bank in Halesowen.
 Her Great Aunt Adelaide was matron at a Mental Hospital in Birmingham, and lived in Norton, Stourbridge until she died.

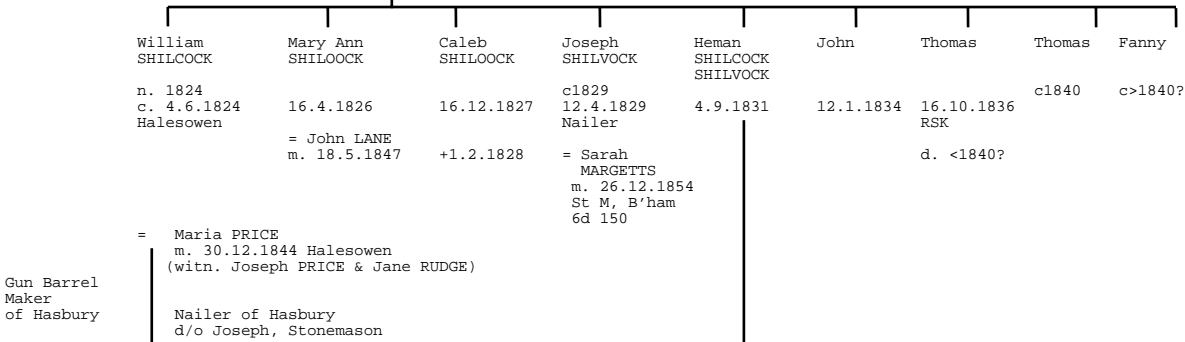

Jennie was born in Canada (her father may have been selling chains from Cradley Heath to the Canadian logging companies) but returned to the UK and is shown as the head of the household in the 1901 census at 32 Sampson Road, Bordesley, Aston with her father Joseph (72) and Sarah her mother (71).

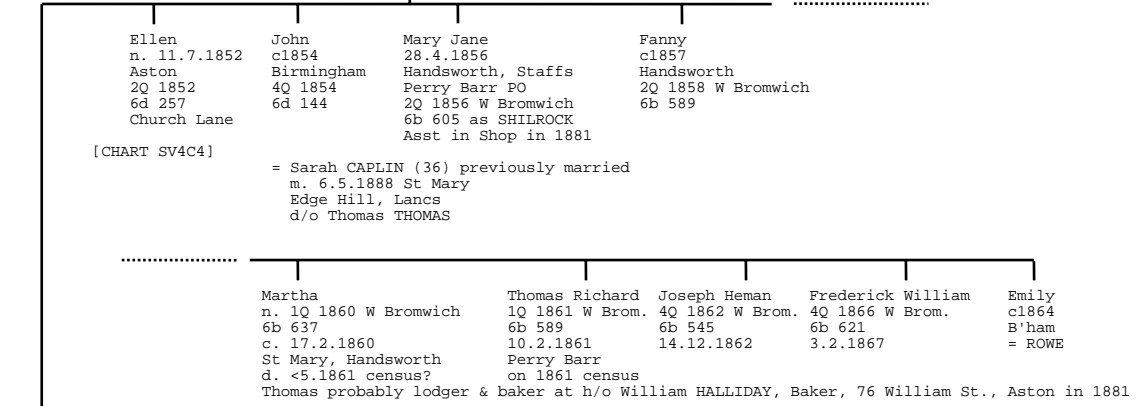

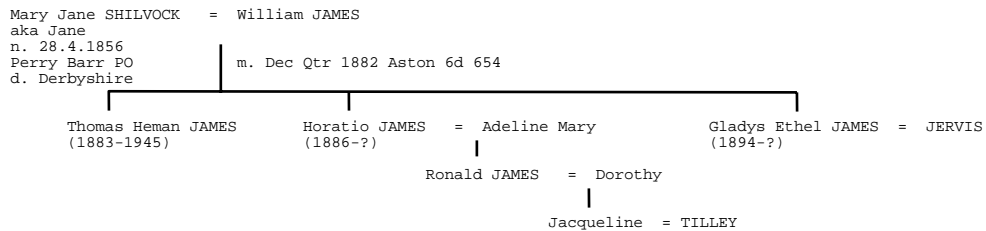

Samuel BRATT was Parish Relieving Officer in Wolverhampton (relief was 2/6d per week), but Brass Founder of Ladywood Birmingham at time of Kate Amelia's birth. Wilfred Edgar BRATT, son of Samuel, was born West Bromwich 1874.



** Sarah Ann's marriage: 1863-1909 at St Catherine's searched. No Sarah Ann Marriages at all prior to 1890 as SHILVOCK. Probably other spelling variations such as SHELVOCK. First child born 1874. If no marriage, therefore 9 illegitimate children.

Gladys JERVIS, who worked at Queen Elizabeth Hospital, knew a Dr SHILVOCK and were believed to be related in some way.

1950's telephone catalogue contained a SHILVOCK firm of engineers in central Birmingham.

The 1851 census at Halesowen reveals how Heman & Martha started their married life at Grove Hill alias Wassell Cottages:

The older generations of the JAMES family tell of an elopement in the past of a Patty SOLEY. Patty's father [a yeoman farmer], chased after the couple on horseback, but was too late to stop the marriage. Patty is a C19th nickname for Martha. Susanna either a child of Herman & Martha SHILVOCK or an earlier (illeg.) child of Martha or Mary (ASHTED) Will of Heman SHILVOCK, head of chart SV4C1, drawn up on 31st July 1911. He left a long list of furniture belonging to his late wife Sarah (See SV4C3) and 6 houses on Aston High Street to his youngest son Harry SHILVOCK, a printer living in one of the houses. He left the balance of his estate to his 6 surviving children from his first marriage:- John, Thomas Richard, Sarah Ann BRATT, Ellen GUEST, Mary Jane JAMES and Emily ROWE. He had lost contact with his oldest son John as he asked his executors to put his share in the bank and try and trace him. If not found within 5 years, then his share was to be divided amongst the other beneficiaries.

SHILVOCK ONE NAME STUDY

"Granny Guest" was remembered at her funeral in 1923, and uncle Harry the printer (actually his great uncle) was present. This means that Helen GUEST, Tim SHILVOCK's great grandmother, is almost certainly Ellen, the daughter of Heman. Ellen is her correct name.

Birmingham Registrar confirms all three marriages relate to the same person i.e. Herman/Heman

At the marriage of Thomas LANE = Phoebe MORRIS at All Saints, West Bromwich in 1858, Heman was a witness. Life long friends suggested as they lived within three doors of each other in 1841 Hasbury and Thomas LANE's first son was named Heman. Heman's sister Mary Ann married Thomas's brother John 11 years earlier, linking the families.

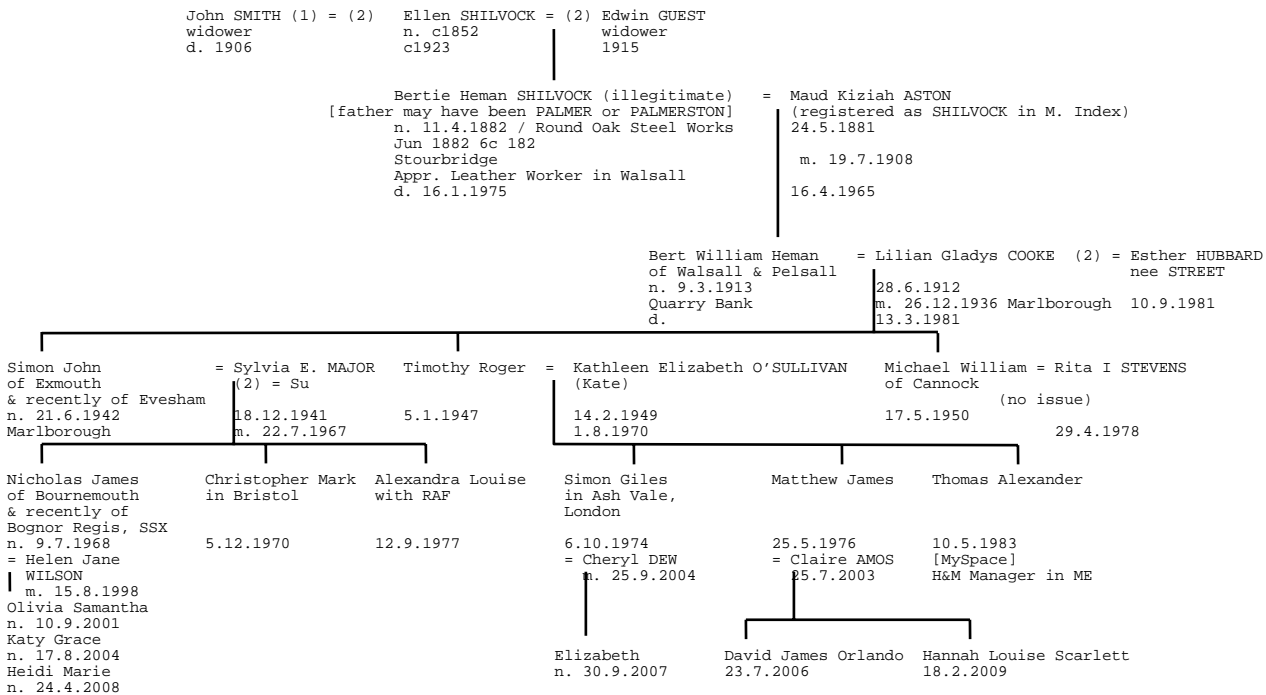

Heman SHILVOCK's will names Ellen GUEST as one of his children. 1911 Census - Ellen GUEST (born Aston, 58) living in Spring Street, Hawne, Halesowen with husband Edwin GUEST (born Woodgate, Northfield, Worcs., 64).

Edwin GUEST, widower, married Ellen SMITH, widow on 2.4.1908 Stourbridge R.O. Ellen's father given as Heman SHILVOCK, Master Baker. Witnesses were Emily ROWE (Ellen's married sister) & Maude ASTON (Ellen's future daughter-in-law).

John SMITH, widower, married Ellen SHILVOCK, spinster, 8.6.1890 at Holy Trinity church, Amblecote near Stourbridge. Ellen's father given as Heman SHILVOCK, baker.

Bertie Heman SHILVOCK - His birth certificate has no father entered. His place of birth was given as "Round Oak Steel Works". He was probably born in one of the workers' houses within the curtilage of the steel works (now the site of the Merry Hill Shopping Centre).

Ellen's future husband, John SMITH, was married with 4 children and living in Rowley Regis at the time of Bertie's birth and is thought unlikely to be Bertie's father. Bertie thought his father's name was PALMER and a more likely candidate is George PALMER, a clay miner, born in Brierley Hill in 1859.

The censuses of 1891 and 1901 both show that Bertie was brought up by George and Phoebe SAVAGE in Quarry Bank.

Bert Heman SHILVOCK, bachelor, married Maud Keziah ASTON, spinster, at the Ebenezer Methodist New Connection Chapel, Stourbridge District on 19.7.1908. The marriage certificate states the couple "Previously went through a ceremony of marriage at this chapel on 4th July 1908, the Parties being then Bachelor and Spinster". The non-conformist chapel was new and may not have had the authority to marry people on the earlier date.

Based on property deeds held in the Dudley Archives: Bertie Heman SHILVOCK bought a row of houses (207-213 Pedmore Road, Woodside, Dudley near the Round Oak Steel Works) from Clara Matilda WARBY, a widow of 728 Eccleshall Road, Sheffield. He was living at 79 High Street, Bloxwich, Walsall, which was also his leather goods shop. He transferred the properties to his sister-in-law (his wife's younger sister) Alice Beatrice ASTON who lived in Coppice Lane, Quarry Bank. The properties were bought by Dudley Council as part of the Enterprise Zone when the steel works were demolished and now lie under the car park of the Merry Hill Shopping Centre.

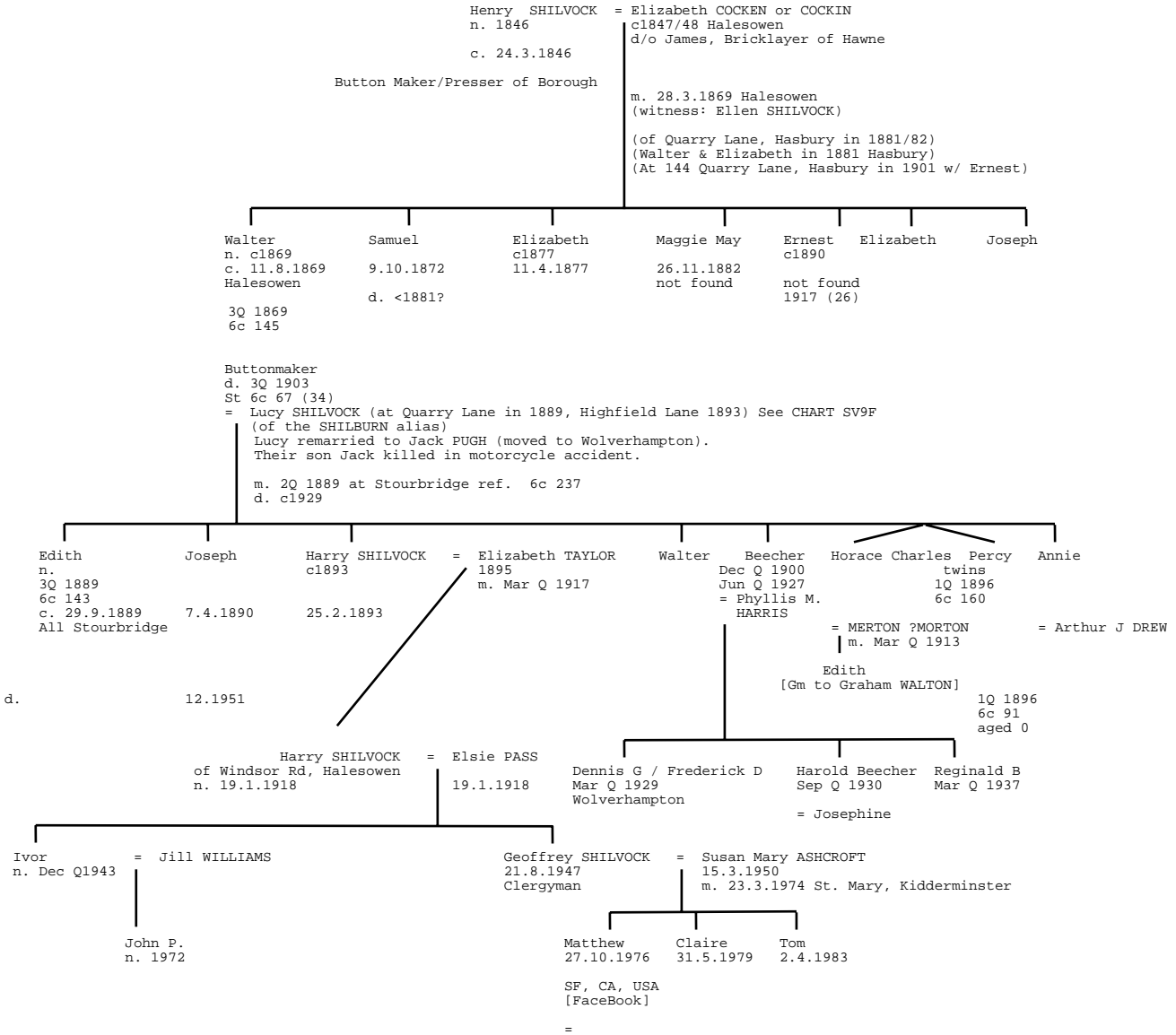

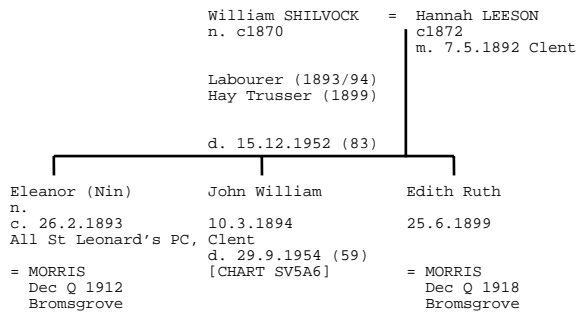

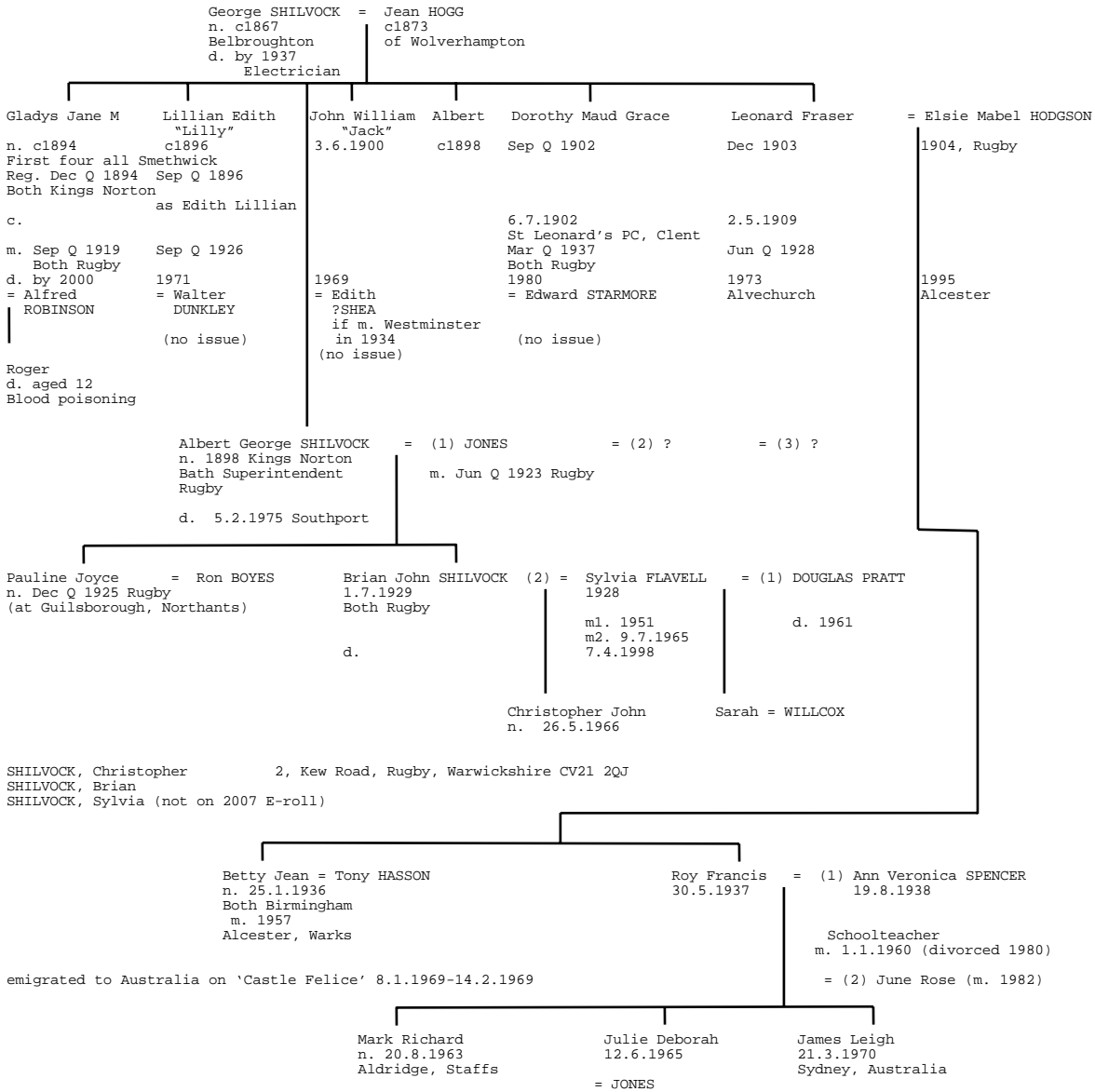

DODDERHILL

An extensive medieval parish, its s end, with the church, now part of Droitwich.

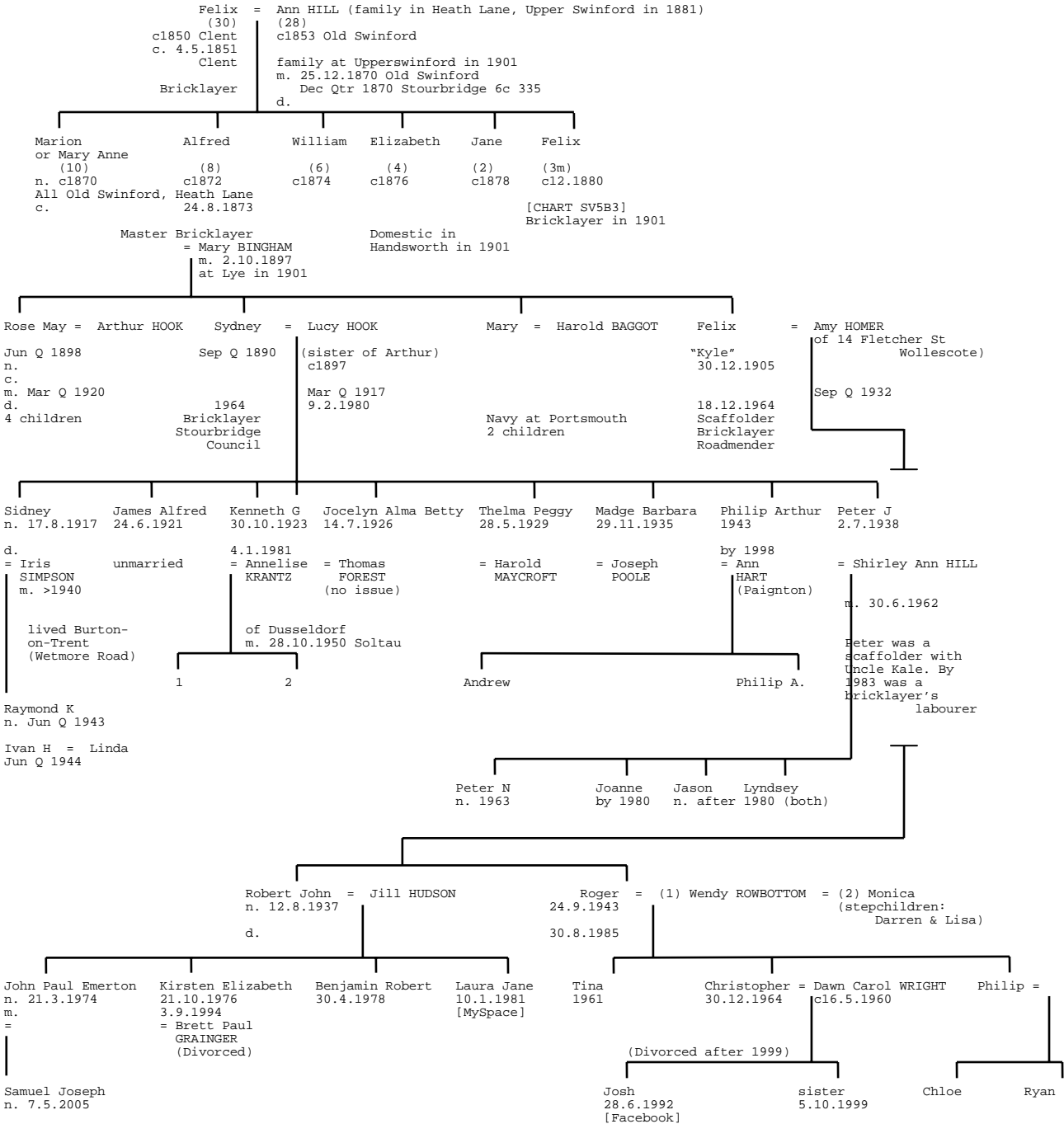
ST AUGUSTINE. A very interesting church, originally cruciform, on the site of the Roman fort overlooking Droitwich (q.v.), and possibly of a Saxon minster. What remains, outside and in, is surprising, its history much obscured by patching because of subsidence, by partial demolition after the Civil War, and by dubious c19 restoration. The mighty four-stage s tower, rebuilt on the site of the medieval s transept in 1708, dominates the exterior; the tooling betrays its date. The central tower was dismantled in the c17, when the nave also disappeared. Much of the material of the demolished tower must have been stored and reused; the two-light bell-openings are clearly late medieval, as is a tiny light for the stair-vice, high up, s side. The long e and w lancets may be c13 survivors of the s transept, their particularly deep splays perhaps the result of thickening the walls to carry the tower. N transept also medieval, partly rebuilt in brick from c. 1803, with tracery (Perp n, Dec w) renewed by *John Shilcock*, 1848. He filled the former arch to the nave with flowing tracery in 1850. The similar tracery in the ambitious Dec chancel may also be untrustworthy; it would be very progressive for 1322, the date

Account of Thomas SHILVOCKs conversion in 1872 to Christadelphian:

" BAPTISM 16 June 1872, aged 39. Former new connexion Methodist preacher. This case is interesting from several points of view. Brother SHILVOCK was a schoolmaster, and had to leave his school some two years ago on embracing the leading principles of the truth. Despairing of finding employment in that line, at all events on a footing admitting of religious independence, he set to work and learnt shoemaking as a means of obtaining a livelihood. This he has mastered and is now following with a measure of success, rejoicing as he says, that though he may not have risen in the social scale by the change he has acquired a position in which he is free to follow his convictions without consulting flesh and blood. It is interesting also to state that he came forward to obey the truth nearly eighteen months ago, and an appointment was made for his immersion, but at the last moment he faltered at the "exclusiveness" of the truth and stayed back. He thought the "harshness" of excluding the bulk of mankind (and many of them sincere) from eternal life on account of their ignorance, could not be of God. Study of the Scriptures since that time has enabled him to see differently and to accept this element of the truth though retaining commiseration for his kind "

He was born in San Jose, CA 12 Mar 1913 (not 1912 as is on his death certificate). Sarah Water SCHMIDT has her grandfather's diary, which states: March 12-1913 Brother born 10:30 a.m. - 7 1/2 lbs. Two days later Bill (the new baby's older brother) and Grandma Etheridge arrive from Joliet to "see" the baby at 5:05. (her grandfather - Benjamin was a railroad man and time was important.)

Modern Florida descendant is Cindy WRIGHT born Jessica Lenore SHELVOCK - 19405 Pine Tree Road Odessa, FL 33556. Tel: (813) 920-6974. Looking to find her birth parents. She was born at Booth Memorial Hospital in Chicago on September 14, 1968. She was put up for adoption. 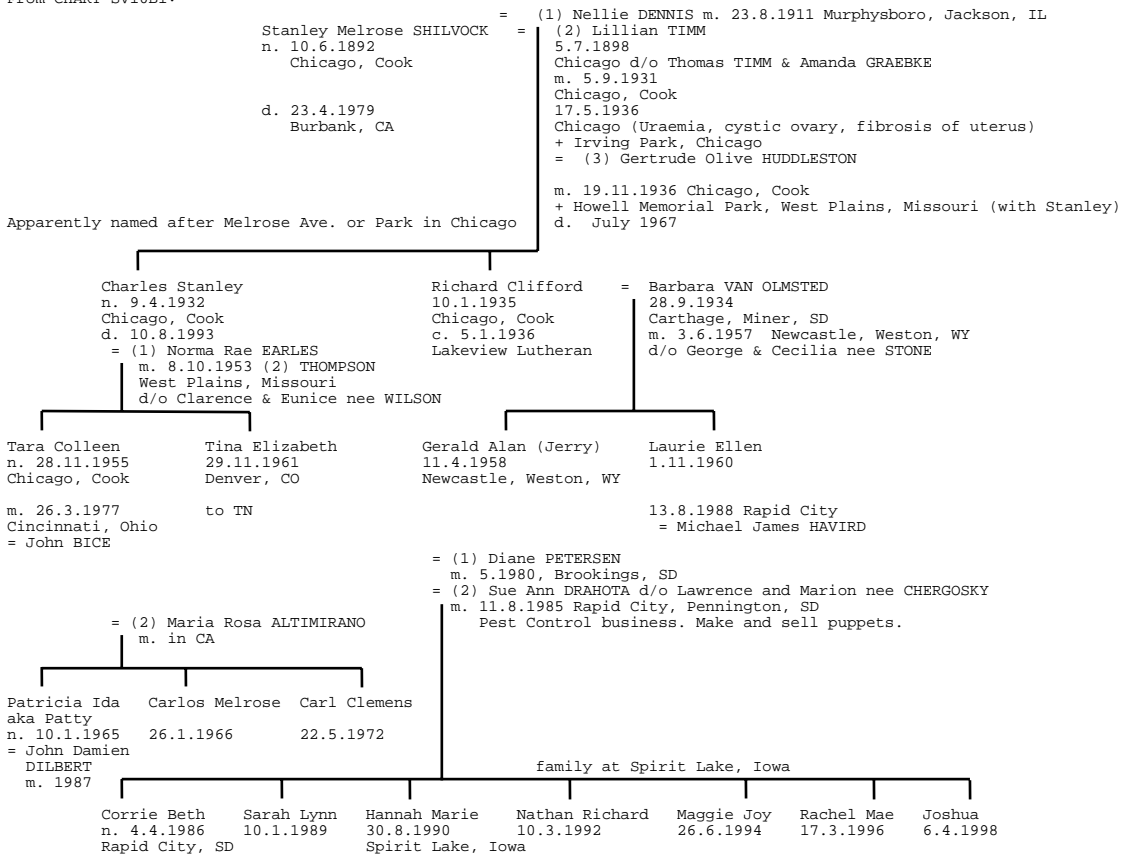
Unknown brother's owned "Great Lakes Paint and Varnish" in Chicago. One brother of William SHILVOCK (grandfather) was killed after being pushed or fell into a vat of varnish at Great Lakes Paint and Varnish. This incident seemed to have happened under very mysterious circumstances. Great grandfather William C. SHILVOCK had numerous patents for inventions. One being a back-water valve installed in sewer systems. There was also the SHILVOCK Foundry in Chicago that made many grates, sewer screens, and manhole covers for Chgo. which are still used today.

In 1920, a group of men in Chicago felt the need for an organization where they could meet and discuss common problems relating to paint and varnish products. John R. MacGregor was selected as the most suitable person to make initial contacts among the local industry people. As a result of his efforts, a meeting was held on December 17, 1920, at the Hamilton Club in Chicago, which saw the founding of the Paint and Varnish Superintendents' Club of Chicago. This new club, which prospered and grew from the outset, subsequently became known as the Chicago Society for Paint Technology. The Society continued to flourish and in 1973, in keeping with the modern role of the industry, the name was again changed to the Chicago Society for Coatings Technology. Today, the Chicago Society is among the two largest of the 26 societies that are affiliated with the Federation throughout the U.S., Canada, Mexico, and the United Kingdom. IN THE INTERMEDIATE COURT OF APPEALS OF THE STATE OF HAWAII

Case Law in Support of our Opinion Our decision is supported by, and we agree with, the opinion of the Illinois Appellate Court in SHILVOCK v. SHILVOCK, 31 Ill. App. 2d 254, 175 N.E.2d 272 (1961). In SHILVOCK, the husband and the first wife were divorced in 1957. The divorce decree required that if the husband predeceased the first wife, the first wife would be entitled to one-half of 1,393 shares of stock that he owned. The husband's will placed the stock in trust and directed the trustee to convey one-half of the 1,393 shares to the first wife. The husband then married the second wife. Upon the husband's death, the first wife petitioned in the divorce case for enforcement of the divorce decree. The executor/trustee of the husband's estate/trust responded that the second wife claimed an interest in the stock. The court ordered compliance with the divorce decree. When the executor/trustee failed to comply, the court responded to first wife's petition by ordering the conveyance to be made within ten days. Before the conveyance was made, the second wife sought leave to intervene on the basis that the stock was an asset of the estate and that an award of the stock to the first wife would diminish her share. The second wife appealed from the denial of her request for intervention and from the order mandating the conveyance to the first wife. On appeal, the appellate court concluded that "both the [Family] and Probate Courts could properly exercise jurisdiction over the subject matter of this controversy. Concurrent jurisdiction of the courts over the identical subject is not unusual and occurs frequently in probate matters." Id. at 260, 175 N.E.2d at 275. It also concluded that the divorce court's denial of the second wife's petition to intervene was in error. Id. at 264, 175 N.E.2d at 277. However, after deciding that the points raised in her petition to intervene were without merit, it concluded that the error was harmless.

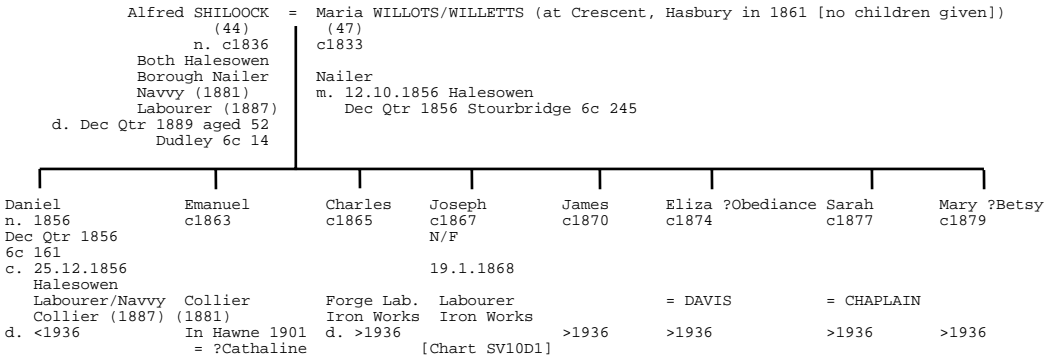

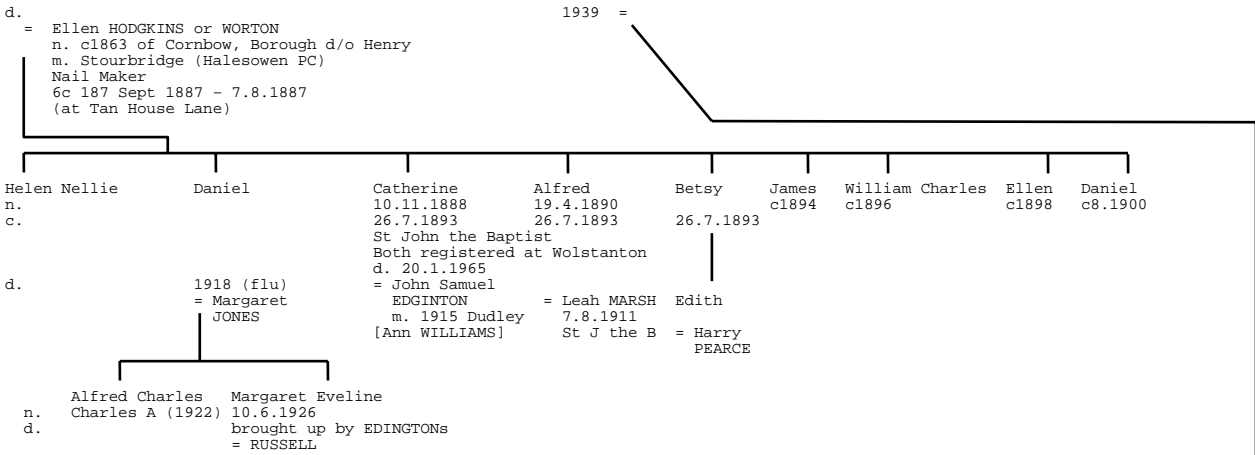

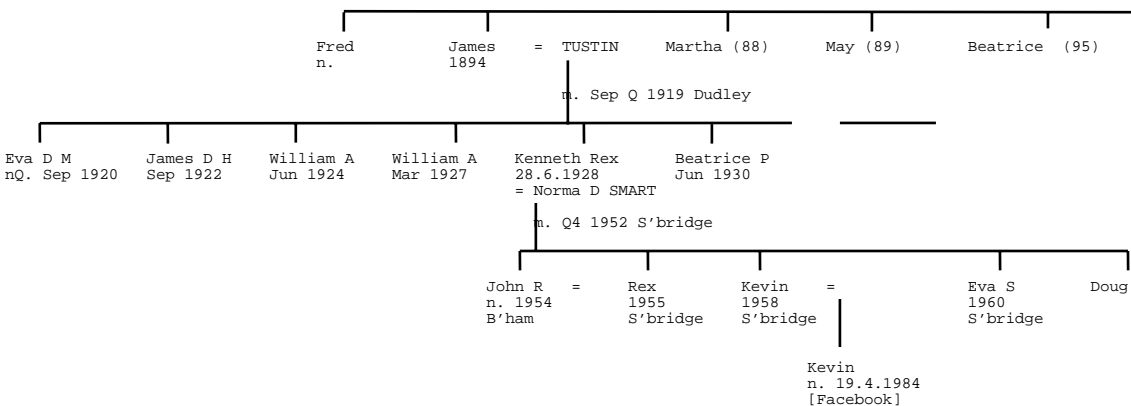

"Betsy Smith SHILVOCK, 73, 2746 Wall avenue, died at four-thirty a.m. today in a local hospital. She had been ill for six week [sic].

"She was born May 9, 1872 at Staffordshire, England, a daughter of Joseph and Marie Smith. Her husband, Joseph SHILVOCK, died seven years ago. She came to Ogden in 1926.

"She is survived by three daughters, Mrs. Leland Pilkington, Smithfield, Utah; Mrs. Ashton H. Cope and Mrs. Frank Jhonnton [sic], Ogden, 15 grandchildren, four great-grandchildren; one brother, Benjamin Smith, England; five sisters, Mrs. Lillian Tout, Mrs. Harry Partridge and Mrs. Ethel Glover, all of England; Mrs. Gertrude Depper, and Mrs. Ted Whitney, both of Los Angeles.

"She was a member of the L.D.S. Second Ward.

"Funeral services will be held Friday and two p.m. at the mortuary 533 Twenty-sixth. Interment, Ogden City cemetery."

Joseph SHILVOCK's obituary lists precisely when he came to the United States, 24 Dec 1924. The major port of immigration to the United States at the time was New York City (Ellis Island):

Joseph SHILVOCK sailed on the steam ship Aurania from Liverpool to New York, departing Liverpool on 6 Dec 1924 and arriving in New York on 16 Dec 1924. The obituary lists that he arrived on 24 Dec 1924, but this may have instead been the date on which he completed clearing customs at Ellis Island. He was a steerage passenger, aged 56 years. Corresponding with the fact that the obituary of Betsy Smith lists that she came to Utah in 1926, the passenger list identifies his next-of-kin in England as his wife, residing at 66 Atwood St., Hawne, Halesowen, which is where she was residing at the time of her marriage to Joseph SHILVOCK in 1917. Joseph SHILVOCK paid his own fare, and his health was described as good, with no deformities. Joseph SHILVOCK had a fresh complexion, with brown hair and grey eyes, with a tattoo on his left arm and a scar on his left leg, and he was six feet, zero inches in height. Joseph SHILVOCK's place of birth is listed as Dudley, England, and his intended final destination was Smithfield, Utah, where he intended initially to reside with his daughter "Mrs. Leland Pilkington". Joseph SHILVOCK intended to reside permanently in the United States and he intended to become a United States citizen. Joseph SHILVOCK had at least \$50 in his possession and he had never before been to the United States. Joseph SHILVOCK travelled on the Aurania with his daughter Nellie SHILVOCK and her husband Frank Johnson, and also with Ashton Harry Cope. The listing for Ashton Harry Cope reveals that his wife, Florence SHILVOCK then still resided in England, at 31 Atwood Street, Hawne, Halesowen. Nellie SHILVOCK is described in the passenger record as a domestic aged 24 years, who was born in Halesowen. Nellie SHILVOCK's health was good, she was not deformed, her height was five feet four inches, she was dark complexioned, with dark brown hair and brown eyes.

The death certificate of Joseph SHILVOCK incorrectly lists that he was a son of James SHILVOCK, as did his obituary. The informant for the obituary is identified as Leland Pilkington of Smithfield, Utah, the husband of Elsie Mary SHILVOCK. The cause of death was a cerebral haemorrhage, which was caused by hypertension and arteriosclerosis. Death occurred at his residence, 2746 Wall Avenue. Joseph SHILVOCK worked as a blacksmith for the county until June 1936, when his condition made it not possible for him to continue.

The death certificate of Betsy Smith lists that she died at the County Infirmary, where she had been for two months. The cause of death was rheumatic heart disease, contributed to by gangrene of her left foot. The informant for her certificate was her daughter Nellie SHILVOCK.

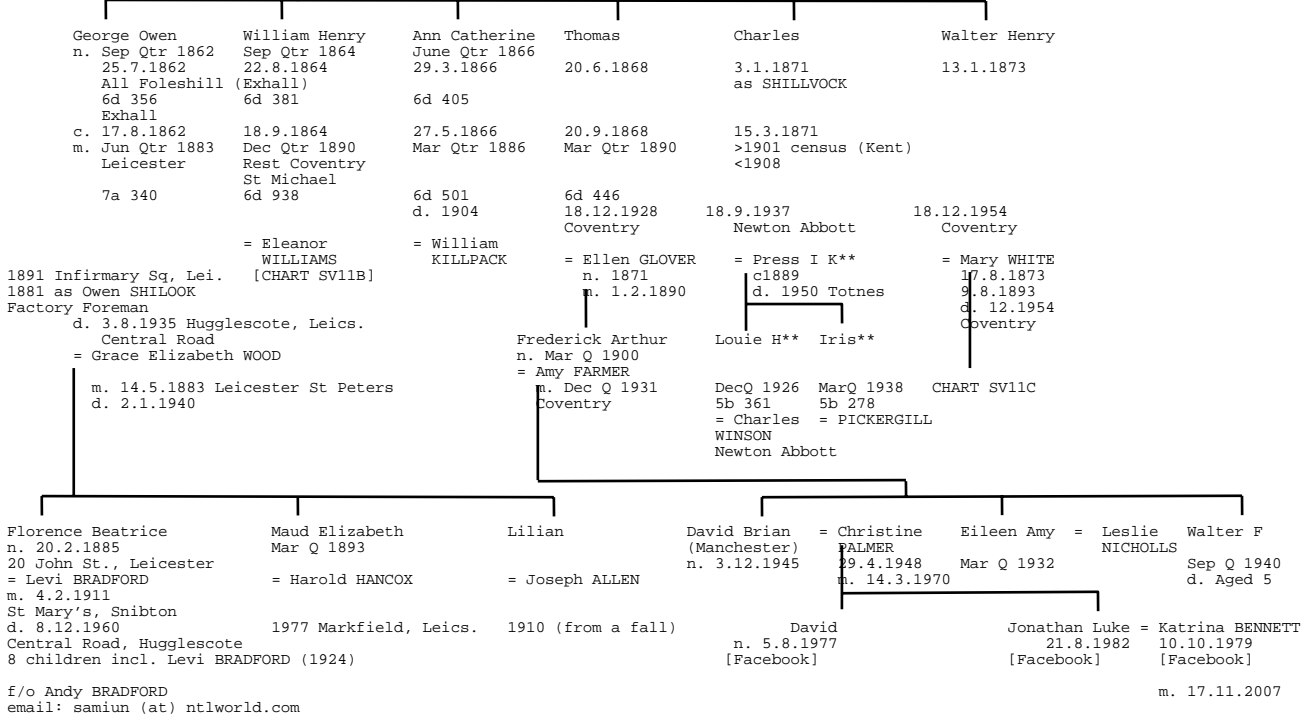

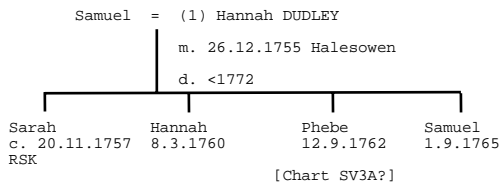

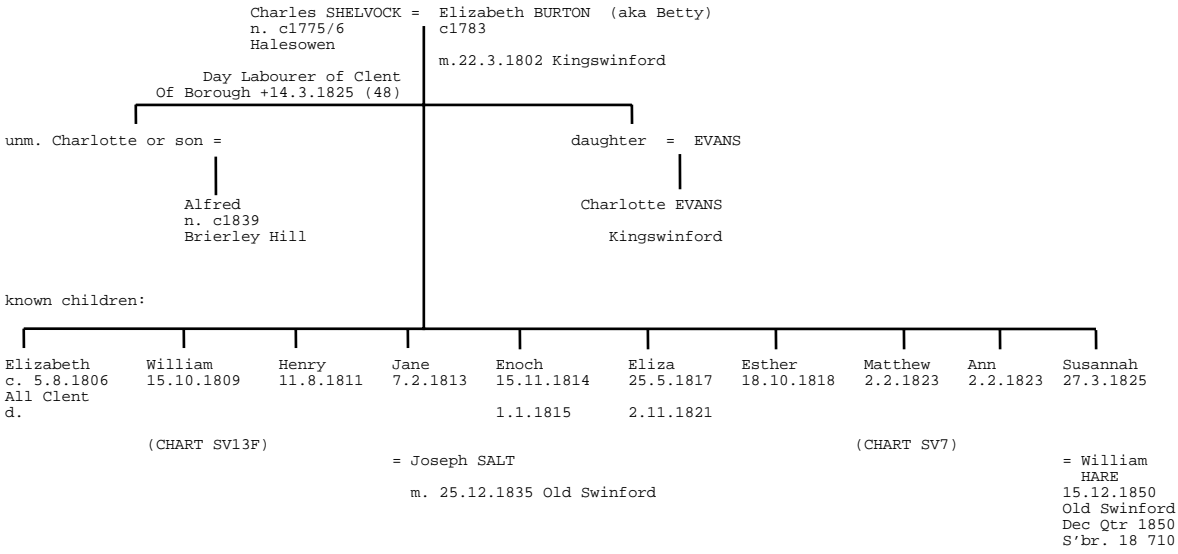

Amelia as SHELVOKE on all children's B. Certs. Although in a common-law marriage prior to 1866 wedding. Bartholomew was seriously ill at the time suffering from phthisis, a wasting disease of the lungs and he died the following year. They had to get married to ensure Amelia was a legal widow, i.e. they knew he was dying. Amelia SHELVOAK is mentioned in the 1851 census (District of St Giles, Willenhall) as 'visitor' at 99 Walsall Street, Willenhall with a FREEMAN family. This family was unusual in that at its head was a 'Emma' FREEMAN (15). The enumerator had remarked 'father and mother from(?) home(?)'. The others siblings are Alfred (unmarried - no age), Ann (8), & Catherine (3). At 96 Walsall Street (probably opposite), the head of family is Mary SHELVOAK, Widow (60). Living with her is Thomas BUTLER (son, unmarried, aged 32). At 97, is Joseph BUTLER and his wife, Mary, both aged 21. Above suggests Mary later married SHELVOAK as a widow and perhaps had Amelia at age 45, unless her earlier children were common-law in her maiden name. That puts her n. c1791, and possibly wife of Samuel as Amelia's father, above. Note: 1790 Samuel s/o Samuel & Sarah. Mary may be Samuel (1790) second wife after Elizabeth. 1841 census has Thomas BUTLER currycomb maker with brother Joseph 12 at Samuel Shelvoke, Walsall St

CHART SV15A: A Brief History of Accles & Shelvoke Ltd.

The firm Bennett's Successors Ltd., was formed on 1.10.1903 by J G ACCLES and 6 other persons, and was funded by 6000 individuals owning a single 10 shilling share. At an Extraordinary General Meeting on 14.1.1914 at the company's registered office of the Talford Street Works, Aston, Birmingham, the company name was changed to Accles & Shelvoke Ltd., (A&S). In 1993, Eley Limited, a subsidiary of IMI plc, acquired A&S and still resides at the above address. No one of the SHELVOKE name is connected with the new company. Some archival material was transferred at the time.

It is unknown what the company produced in the early C20th, and Gordon Edwin SHELVOKE (s/o George SHELVOKE, below) in the notes he wrote after J G ACCLES death only refers to "experimental work". In the deeds of A&S a Mrs Emma SHELVOKE (historian assumes is G E's mother) leased houses in Phillip St., (nos. 49, 51 & 53) to Bennett's Successors Ltd. The deeds also mention a house in Mansfield Road, Birchfield that at one time belonged to the SHELVOKE family. The historian also listed the following facts concerning a factory in Talford Street, or possibly in Phillips Street:

1898: George SHELVOKE retired from his business at the Talford Street Works and let the Works to another company.

1896: C SHELVOKE & Co. was also working in a part of the same Works.

1891: Phillips Street Nos. 49-57 inclusive plus "shop" various tenants under the owner George SHELVOKE (Poor Rate, Vol. 2).

1890: George & James SHELVOKE, Weavers mail makers at Talford St Works (Kelley's Directory)

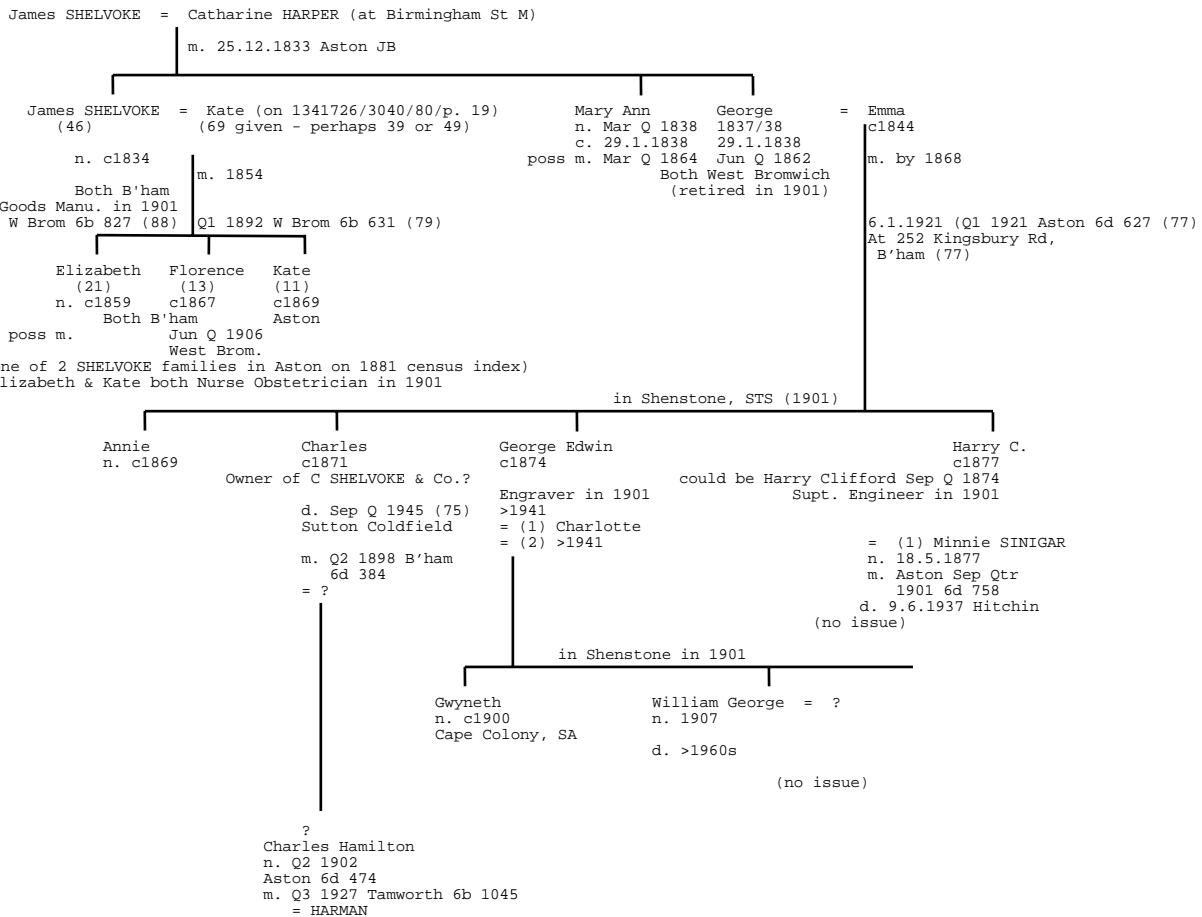
1876: as above (Hulley's Directory)

1833: James SHELVOKE = Catherine HOOPER or HARPER 25.12.1833 at St Paul & St Michael, Aston

The historian notes that there is only one reference for SHELVOKE in the Birmingham Central Library concerning a C SHELVOKE who died in 1955; an old boy of Bishop Vesey's School. G E SHELVOKE's son and daughter both died without issue and his son's surviving widow did not respond to the historian's letter. The Talford Street Works has two photographs; the first showing Gordon Edwin SHELVOKE on a Works outing in 1941, lighting his pipe (in the narrative he was accompanied by his second wife), and the second showing William George SHELVOKE, his son, in the 1960's.

Historical items with the SHELVOKE brand name: includes the SHELVOKE dustcart used in one of the episodes of "Dad's Army", and the SPV tender used in the TV series "London's Burning". The firm also made miniature submarines during WW2.

"As early as 1924, the Association travelled to Greece and Italy to press for improvements in animal welfare. In 1950 a member of the HAS (Humane Slaughter Assoc.) left £6,000 to help introduce humane slaughter in Canada. A joint project was set up between Miss Sidley, General Secretary of the HSA and Mr SHELVOKE, then Managing Director of Accles and SHELVOKE, a major firearms manufacturer. Slaughter demonstrations were arranged and carried out at Canada Packers by an expert slaughterman. As a result, the Canadian Parliament passed regulations enforcing the use of humane methods."

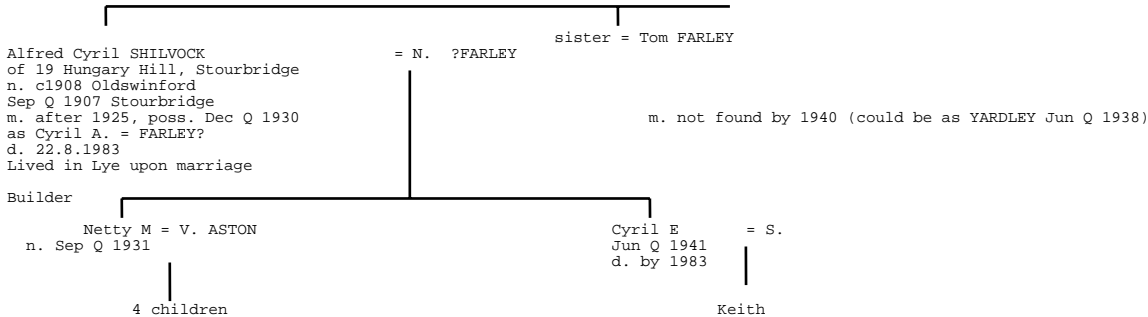

The Worcesters were ordered to fight their way up the steep wooded slopes of the river Ancre under intense artillery and heavy machine gun fire. They did not quite succeed, but held on for four days until 8th July. Although losses were heavy, the next day they were ordered to help in the critical battle around the nearby village of Ovillers. For five days the battalion was in the line and a local man, Lt J. Mould of Wordsley, was awarded the DSO for his leadership.

After these efforts the 25th Division retired to a quieter sector, but only until 18th August. Then it returned to the Leipzig Salient, the German strongpoint which had resisted all attacks since 1 July. In very hot weather on 24th August the Worcesters and Wiltshires attacked under a devastating barrage and seized Lemberg trench. They then resisted shelling, bombing and counter-attack for two days and managed to hold the valuable territory they had gained. But the costs had been high. L/Cpl SHILVOCK together with 37 other men were killed, with 15 missing and 173 wounded. Also killed was Lt/Col W. Gibbs, commanding the battalion, whose father had been Rector of Hagley and who is commemorated by a memorial window in St. John's church.

John SHILVOCK had come through some of the worst fighting on the Somme, but was killed when a shell landed in his trench. His name is commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, which was built near the site of the Leipzig Salient where he died. John SHILVOCK's death left a widow and two young children. He had two brothers who served in the war and both are recorded on the St. Mary's memorial of those who served their country. Pte Alfred SHILVOCK, aged 27 in 1916, and Pte William SHILVOCK, aged 19 in 1916, of 17 Heath Lane were both in the Army Service Corps. [Source: County Express 22 September 1916]

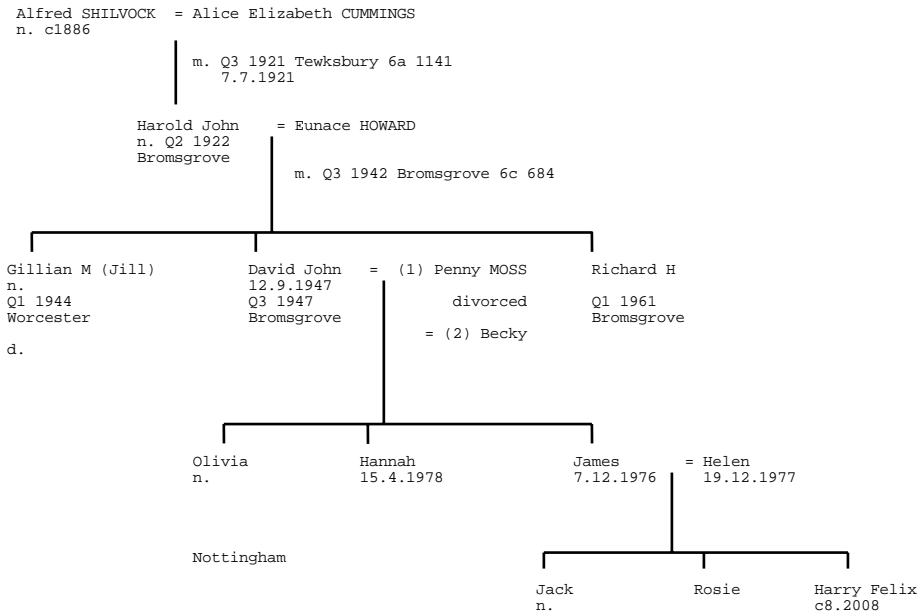

CHART SV37: Bromsgrove ancestry of Olivia SHILVOCK and James & Helen SHILVOCK [Facebook]

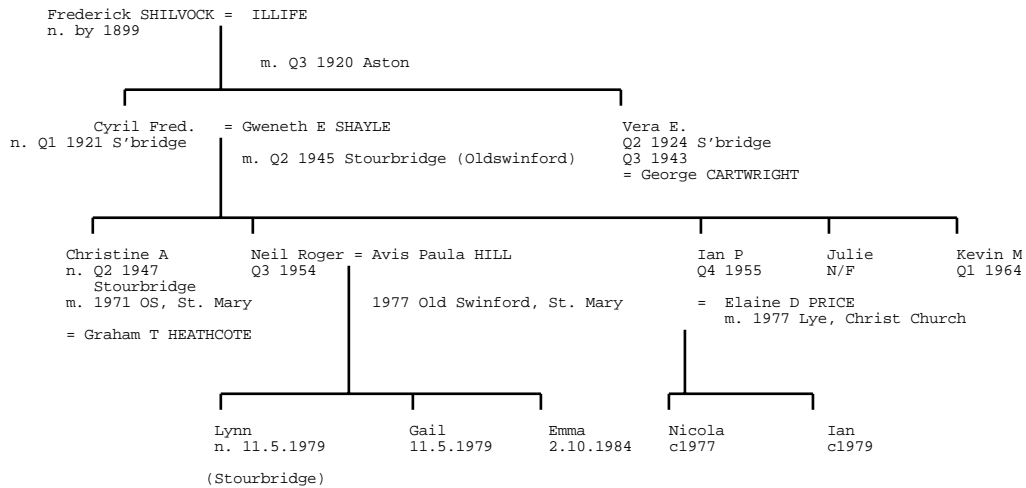

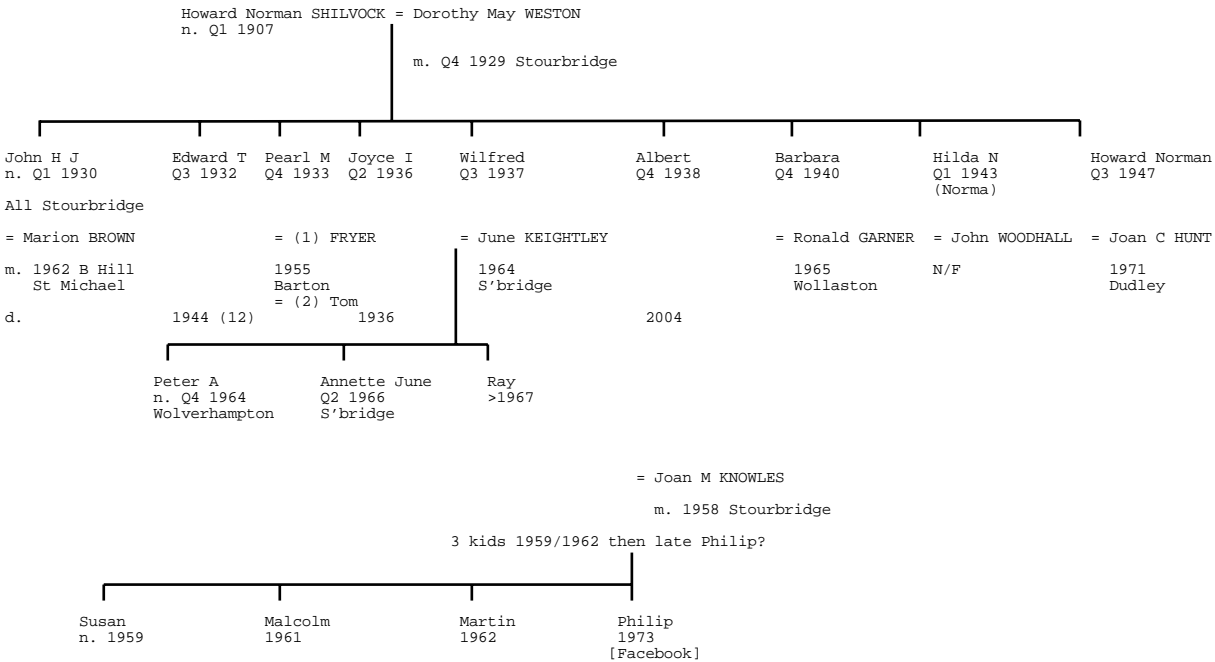

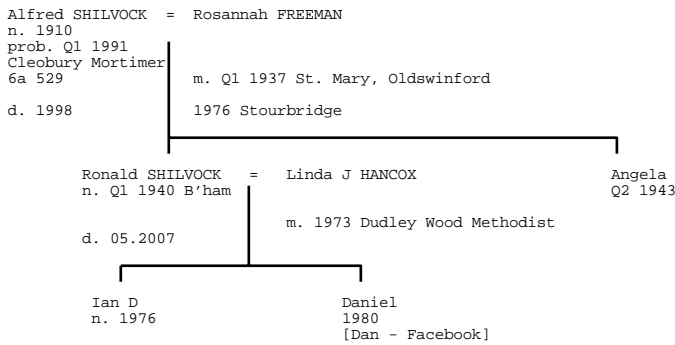

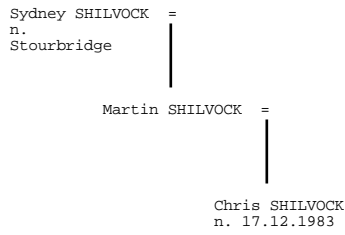
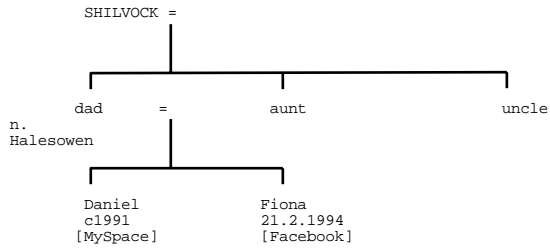


CHART SV42: Ancestry of Daniel & Fiona SHILVOCK [MySpace & Facebook]

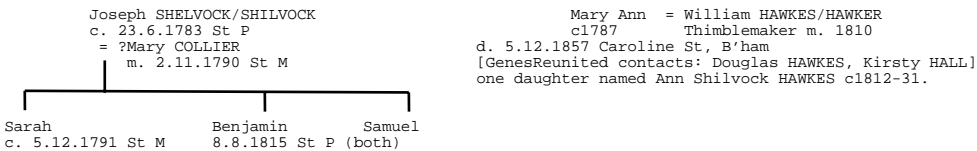

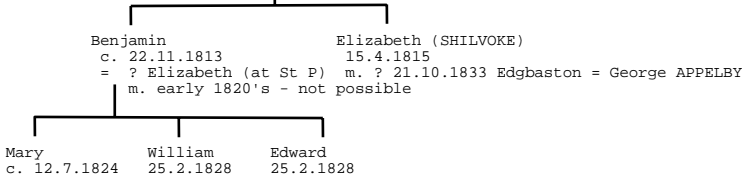

[Classes 9 (i) and 92 (ii)] A magazine and magazine-charging device for a machine gun or other magazine firearm comprises a curvilinear box 4 constituting the magazine and a charger 1 of similar curvilinear form which slides within the magazine to load the cartridges thereinto and is then withdrawn, the cartridges being retained in the magazine by a spring-pressed catch 7. The charger has arms 1 to receive the rim and bullet ends of the cartridges, the arms having spring tongues 5 at their ends to prevent displacement of the cartridges, which are held in the same staggered relation in the charger which they are required to occupy in the magazine. Gaps 2 between the arms allow ribs 11, Fig. 2, on the inside of the magazine to support the sides of the cartridges when the charger is slid into the magazine, the spring catch 7 wiping over the sides of the cartridges during their introduction into the magazine. The magazine has a hook 13, and a projection 14 which is engaged by a catch to retain the magazine in position on the receiver 9 of the firearm, when the magazine has been loaded, the positioning of the loaded magazine on the receiver causing a projection 10 on the receiver to engage the catch 7 and thereby release the cartridges for supply to the receiver under the action of the magazine follower.

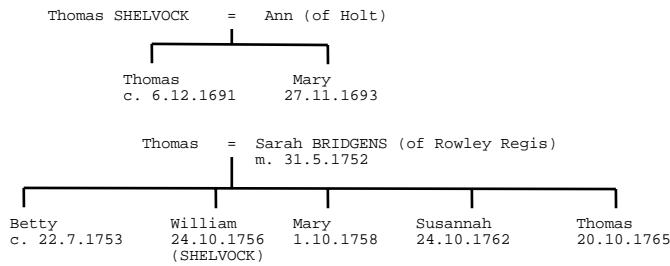
